



**Arrival time:** Plan to arrive for dinner at 6:15 pm on the first day of camp. Registration will open at **4:00 pm** in front of Rivendell Lodge: please do not arrive before 4:00. Camp concludes with brunch at 11:00 am on the closing day.

**PACKING:** Please make sure you bring the following. Clothes should be able to take a lot of wear and tear. Do not bring items that would cause grief if they are lost or damaged!

**Label all belongings with your first and last name.** Lost & Found items will be kept for 3 weeks only. Found items will be returned if requested at your expense.

### **Essentials for FAMILY CAMPS**

- Boots (shoes) with heels & long pants (Required in the barn & riding arenas).
- Hiking shoes, runners, and flip-flops (sandals)
- Rain gear, warm jacket (just in case)
- Comfortable clothes (t-shirts, shorts, sweatshirt etc.)
- Sleeping bag & pillow
- Pajamas
- Swimwear, beach towel
- Towel, face cloth, toothbrush
- Personal hygiene items
- Water Bottle (large size)
- Flashlight
- Hat, Sunscreen
- Bug Spray (appreciated in the barn area)
- Optional: camera, small day pack, fishing gear & valid license.

### **WHAT NOT TO BRING:**

- Tobacco, alcohol, marijuana, or illegal drugs (Zero Tolerance). No vaping.
- Computer games, sheath knives
- Campers will be required to pay for intentional damages or loss of equipment due to carelessness.

### **What we provide:**

- Life Jackets/PFDs (smallest fits 9-14 kg or 20-31 lbs)
- High chairs for children under 2
- 2-3" thick sleeping mats for our platform tents
- 'Super Happy Fun Time' activity blocks for ages 2-4 (to give parents time to themselves)

## DRESS CODE:

- **Long pants & boots** (shoes) with heels must be worn while riding.
- Please pack modest clothing for camp.
- **Girls Swimwear:** One piece, tankini, rashguard or boardshorts.  
Casual wear: no short shorts, crop tops or spaghetti strap tank tops.
- **Boys Swimwear:** Board shorts that fit (not too big, not too tight).  
Casual wear: shirts must be worn unless at waterfront.

**Activities:** Homewood offers a wide range of great activities including canoeing, swimming, horseback riding, archery, riflery, volleyball, and crafts. We also host special events such as Carnival, Aquatic Day, firesides, outdoor meals, and more!

**Tuck Shop & Homewood Hut:** The Tuck Shop will be open daily after lunch for candy, chocolate, and pop sales. Tuck is NOT included in the price of camp. The daily spending limit is \$3.00 for children. You may purchase a family tuck card in advance or upon arrival.

The Hut will be open daily during camp for custom t-shirt and sweatshirt sales as well as hats, water bottles, sunglasses and more. Prices start at: t-shirts \$20, hoodies \$40, hats \$35, water bottles \$18. We accept debit or credit cards as well as cash. *Custom camp apparel can be ordered online when you register.*

## BC Ferry Sailing Information:

**Horseshoe Bay** (West Vancouver) **to Departure Bay** (Nanaimo): Check the BC Ferries Website for information [www.bcferrries.com](http://www.bcferrries.com). Summer traffic is very heavy - we recommend you book a reservation. Drive from the ferry terminal in Nanaimo to Campbell River via the Inland Island Highway (approx. 1.5 hours) or enjoy the scenic coastal route (approx. 2.5 hours).

**Tsawwassen to Duke Point** (south of Nanaimo): Check the BC Ferries website for information [www.bcferrries.com](http://www.bcferrries.com). Summer traffic is very heavy - we recommend you book a reservation. Drive from the ferry terminal in Nanaimo to Campbell River via the Inland Island Highway (approx. 2 hours) or enjoy the scenic coastal route (approx. 3 hours).

*Please ensure that you board your ferry to Vancouver Island from the mainland prior to 1:00 pm in order to arrive at camp in time for supper.*

**From Campbell River:** Take the 12 minute ferry from Campbell River to Quathiaski Cove on Quadra Island. For sailing info, check out [www.bcferrries.com](http://www.bcferrries.com). Expect a 1 sailing delay! Follow the signs toward the Heriot Bay Ferry. Homewood is 5 km north on West Road.
